

The Breaking of the Bread We break the bread of life, and that life is the light of the world. **God here among us, light in the midst of us, bring us to light and life.**

The Communion *Come to the left of the steps to receive the bread. After it is placed in your hands, you may remove your mask. Then step in front of the chalice bearer. Either drink from the cup or cross your arms to indicate your wish to honour it. The chalice bearer will say "The cup of salvation". Taking only the bread is considered a full communion. Dipping the wafer in the wine is not allowed.*
